"If there is any encouragement in Christ, any comfort from love, any participation in the Spirit, any affection and sympathy, complete my joy by being of the same mind, having the same love, being in full accord and of one mind." Philippians 2:1-2

"... when we embrace Christ in all of His love and accept the salvation He won for us at the cross, we are united with him - and we are never the same again... Our relationship with Him is a gift of God's grace to us, and we can find security in the knowledge that through the power of His Spirit, He is with us everywhere we go. If you are united with Christ by faith, He is closer to you than you are to your own hands and feet. Your life is permanently interwoven with the Lord.

One of the prevailing difficulties of 21st-century life is that so many of us feel at times forlorn, bereft of companionship, and alone even when we're in the midst of a crowd... Truly, though, Christians need not feel that despair, because we know and experience the reassurance of our union with

Christ. He both knows us completely and loves us infinitely...The "comfort" Paul speaks of here isn't just a simple, cozy feeling; the word describes something with power and attractiveness to it. It is a doing word: comfort flows out into our relationships with each other, for the Spirit unites us not only to Himself but also to one another even on this side of heaven. The more we enjoy the benefits of our union with Christ- the most precious of which is Christ Himself- the more we will grow closer to, and more deeply loving of, our brothers and sisters in faith...

Our knowledge of Christ's mercy and compassion ought to compel us to show affection and sympathy to one another as we grow in our union with Him. It is possible for us to be hardened by life's bumps and bruises, possible for us to lack the grace which reveals itself in tenderness, possible for us to be so taken up with ourselves that we fail to love others...ask the Spirt to show you anyone who needs encouragement or comfort today, and be the means by which Christ's comfort is brought to them."

Pastor Search Committee Update:

"The Search Committee, on behalf of the congregation, is seeking to understand the mind of Christ about whom He has called to be the pastoral leader of this congregation." EPC Procedure Manual for Ministerial Candidates an Committees, Chapter 6 Orienting the Search Committee.

The Search Committee met on July 18, 2025, to participate in Search Committee training taught by Ed Cummings, the Stated Clerk of the EPC Presbytery of the Pacific Northwest, orient us to the search process, and to set up voting, record keeping, communication processes. The committee was provided with the Church Information Form (CIF), which will be used to notify Presbytery of our pastor vacancy and solicit candidates for our open Teaching Elder (Pastor) position. Candidates may respond to our vacancy announcement, be referred from the EPC Ministerial Committee or referred from our congregation. A chairman, vice-chairman, and secretary were elected. A covenant of confidentiality was established with clear boundaries for the committee. The names of individuals being reviewed by the committee will be kept confidential, even from committee family members.
